MARKET RULES

The South Valley Growers' Market is located at 3907 Isleta Blvd. in the parking lot of the Cristo del Valle Presbyterian Church. The market's hours of operation for the 2008 season will be on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to noon from June 14 through November 1, as weather permits.

1. The seasonal fee is \$55. First-time vendors have the option of two trial days at \$20 each. Two days paid at the daily rate can accrue toward the annual fee. A first-time vendor is defined as someone who has not sold at a farmers' market in the past. Seasonal fees must be paid in full on or before vendors begin selling at the market. Daily fees will be collected at the beginning of the market day.
2. Vendors shall sell only agricultural, horticultural, or arts and crafts items that they themselves have grown, produced, or processed. Reselling is strictly prohibited.
3. Dairy products, canned goods, baked goods, and other processed foods must be made in a licensed kitchen. Licenses shall be displayed at the vendor's booth.
4. There will be no sales prior to the opening of the market.
5. Vendors may display their prices.
6. Vendors are encouraged to sell their products at premium prices. Radical price cutting of top quality produce is prohibited. Poor quality or overripe produce shall not be sold. Dumping of produce is strictly prohibited.
7. Vendors must clean up their stalls before leaving the market.
8. Vendors must comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of the United States, State of New Mexico, and County of Bernalillo.
9. Vendors may submit suggestions, comments, or complaints in writing to the executive committee. These will be reviewed by the executive committee.
10. Violations of any market regulations will be dealt with by the executive committee.

The executive committee may give a verbal warning notice to a vendor for an infraction of the rules. Two verbal warning notices constitute expulsion from the market. The vendor may appeal this decision in writing to the executive committee. The executive committee's decision is final.

11. The executive committee reserves the right to conduct farm inspections.
12. The annual fee allows a vendor to occupy a 10-by-10-foot space. We strongly encourage each participant to supply his/her own canopy.
13. All vendors are expected to participate in the setup or takedown of the market on a rotating basis.
